

Financial Guideline 2016/2017 - 07

Revised hourly rate of pay applicable from January 2017 for privately paid Caretakers and Secretaries

1. Introduction

The Department of Education and Skills have issued <u>Circular 0081/2016</u> 'Revision of Pay Rates in 2017 for Grant funded School Secretaries, Caretakers and Cleaners employed by the Boards of Management of Voluntary Secondary Schools in the Free Education System and Associated increases in Grant funding for same'. The Circular was issued as a result of Phase 2 of the agreement reached with the Union side on foot of the Arbitrator's findings in relation to the pay of grant-funded School Secretaries and Caretakers and the Financial Emergency Measures in the Public Interest Act 2015. This Financial Guideline details the first of three pay increases arising in 2017.

2. Minimum Hourly Rate for Caretakers & Secretaries

Effective from the 1st of January 2017 a minimum hourly rate of €10.75 should be implemented for Caretakers and Secretaries. The minimum hourly rate of €10.75 applies to School Secretaries & Caretakers employed by schools who are <u>not</u> currently paid on a salary scale equivalent to a public service salary scale and whose pay is funded from SSSF, Secretary and Caretaker grants.

Schools who have insufficient funds in 2017 to pay the new minimum hourly rate should complete the application form for additional funding included in Appendix 1. This form should be completed and returned to the Department of Education and Skills no later than 31st March 2017.

Note: Caretakers & Secretaries who are currently paid an hourly rate in excess of $\in 10.75$ are not due any pay increases at this time.

3. Increases in Grant funding

Appendix 2 sets out the revised rates of School Services Support Fund Grant, Secretary/SSSF Grant and Caretaker/SSSF Grants in order to enable schools to pay the salary increases due in 2017. Please note there are further pay increases due for Secretaries, Caretakers and Cleaners. The grants detailed in Appendix 2 are to cover all pay increases during 2017. The FSSU will issue a guideline before each pay increase is due.

Further information or clarification on any of the issues raised in this Guideline can be obtained from the FSSU.

Appendix 2

Revised Rates of School Services Support Fund Grant, Secretary Grant/SSSF Secretary and Caretaker Grant/SSSF Caretaker grant funding to Voluntary Secondary Schools in the Free Education Scheme

(for payment in January 2017)

School Services Support Fund (SSSF)

The SSSF grant is increased from €206 to €210 per pupil

Grants for Secretaries

The Basic Secretary Grant is increased from €37 to €38 per pupil

The SSSF Secretary Grant is increased from €25 to €25.50 per pupil

Schools employing secretaries under 'the 1978 scheme' do not receive any secretary grants.

Grants for Caretakers

The Basic Caretaker Grant is increased from €31 to €31.50 per pupil

The SSSF Caretaker Grant is increased from €19 to €19.50 per pupil

The revised rates include provision for Employer's PRSI.
