Grants administered by Schools Division Financial to Voluntary Secondary Schools in the Free Education Scheme

Rates with effect from 1st January 2016

The Minister for Education and Skills wishes to advise the Management Authorities of Voluntary Secondary Schools in the Free Education Schools of funding to be allocated in respect of current grants.

<u>1. Standard Capitation Grant</u> €296 per pupil, less the contribution to teachers' salaries. The grant is paid in three instalments in September, January and April.

<u>2. School Services Support Fund (SSSF)</u> €206 per pupil payable in three instalments in September, January and April. Each eligible school receives the SSSF grant, which is calculated at a minimum enrolment rate of 200 pupils and thereafter according to enrolment.

<u>3. Grants for Secretaries</u>

Basic Secretarial Grant * SSSF Secretary Grant ** €37 per pupil €25 per pupil

Schools employing secretaries under 'the 1978 scheme' do not receive any secretary grants.

4. Grants for Caretakers

Basic Caretaker Grant *€31 per pupilSSSF Caretaker Grant **€19 per pupil

To qualify for the basic secretary and caretaker grants*, a school must have an enrolment figure of at least 200 pupils. The grant is calculated by multiplying the enrolment figure by the rate up to a maximum of 350 pupils.

All schools, regardless of enrolment, receive the SSSF caretaker and secretary grants**, which are calculated at a minimum enrolment rate of 200 pupils and thereafter according to enrolment up to a maximum of 350 pupils.

5. Special Class Grant

Pupils psychologically assessed as having a mild or moderate general learning disability and participating in NCSE approved special classes

6. Irish and Bilingual Grants
