Cost of Living Grant to support Post-Primary Schools in the Free Education Scheme

1. Introduction

<u>Circular 0056/2023</u> advises that additional funding is being provided as part of the Budget 2024 cost of living measures. This is to ensure financial supports are available for recognised post-primary schools in the Free Education Scheme to meet additional energy costs and other increased day to day running costs.

The first instalment of this grant will be issued to schools shortly. The balance of the grant will be issued in 2024.

2. Main features of the grant

- The grant will be calculated based on recognised pupil enrolment at 30th September 2022.
- Enhanced rates are payable in respect of pupils attending special schools and special classes and traveller pupils attached to mainstream schools.
- It is expected that schools should not have to seek additional voluntary contributions from parents.
- Board of managements should continue to seek support in relation to procurement for bulk heating fuels and electricity rates from the Schools Procurement Unit website <u>www.spu.ie</u>
