Allied Irish Banks (AIB)

AIB's business ebanking service is iBusiness Banking (iBB).

How to Get Started on iBusiness Banking (iBB)

- Make sure you possess a Business Account with AIB.
- You will be required to complete the [iBB Application form](#)
- To complete the iBusiness Banking form you will need:
 - Names of all users that you want to access iBusiness Banking.
 - Account details for all accounts you want to view on iBusiness Banking.
 - The date of the meeting to pass the iBusiness Banking resolution.
 - A printer to print the completed application form.

- Visit your local branch
- Complete the registration form
- Provide supporting documentation
 - Once the bank receives your proof of address, form of identification and a completed registration form (available in-branch), their Advisor will issue you with a unique

Business24 number. The submitted documentation will be sent to the registration team which takes 24 hours to process.
