

Excess Funds being used for Capital Projects

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1. Introduction

The board of management may decide that excess funds within their reserves can be allocated for a specific purpose, e.g. capital work. As with any capital building project, patron or trustee approval would be required prior to commencement of works.

2. Accounting Treatment

The expenditure can be recorded in the normal way and there is no requirement to adjust reserves' balances.

2.1 Example – Using excess funds for a building project.

2.2 Transfer to Land/Building Fund Account

The year after the capital building project is complete the expenditure should be transferred to the land/building fund account.
